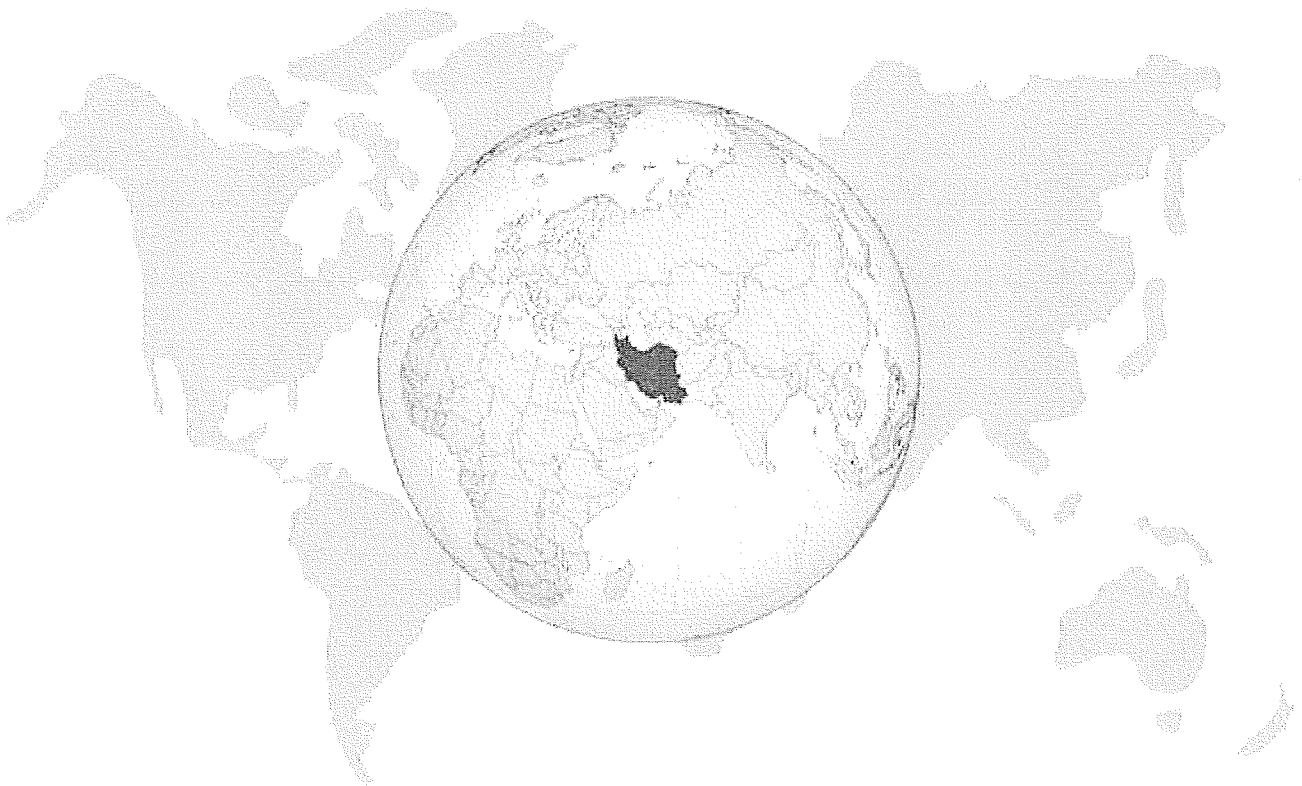

The First International Meeting of Elite Women in Academia and Administration with the slogan of “Women and the Training of Flourishing Generation” will be held on 13-14 February, 2024 in Tehran, Iran. The Vice Presidency for Women and Family Affairs of the Islamic Republic of Iran is the host of this event, in collaboration with the Ministry of Science, Research, and Technology; and the Ministry of Health, Treatment, and Medical Education. The logistics and administrative arrangements for the event are as follow:

1. Venue and dates of the Meeting

The meeting will be held in Tehran, Iran (13-14 February, 2024).

2. Registration

All the filled-in Registration Forms are to be sent to women.in.academia.2024@gmail.com with a copy to cws@ut.ac.ir no later than 14 December 2023. A confirmation email will be sent after registration is completed.

3. Hospitality

Local hospitality (accommodation, selected meals, local transport, and airport transfer) will be offered to all distinguished guests who receive the invitation letter. All the reservation will be made by the host.

4. Entry Visa Procedures

All guests are required to possess a valid passport with an expiration date at least 6 months prior to the date of entry into Iran. Please fill out the visa form which can be found at evisa.mfa.ir. Guests with no Iranian embassy in their countries should submit their request to women.in.academia.2024@gmail.com no later than 14 December 2023 to receive a Visa on Arrival (VoA).

5. Medical requirements

Medical facility for the guests will be provided in case it deems necessary. The Guests will be responsible for the costs of treatment.

6. Dress Code

Women are kindly requested to cover their hair with a headscarf or shawl and avoid wearing short skirts or see-through leggings/pants.

7. Other Information

Language

The native language of the IRI is Persian, also known as Farsi. English language will be the working language during the event. If you need an interpreter for the language you speak, please kindly contact us at women.in.academia.2024@gmail.com.

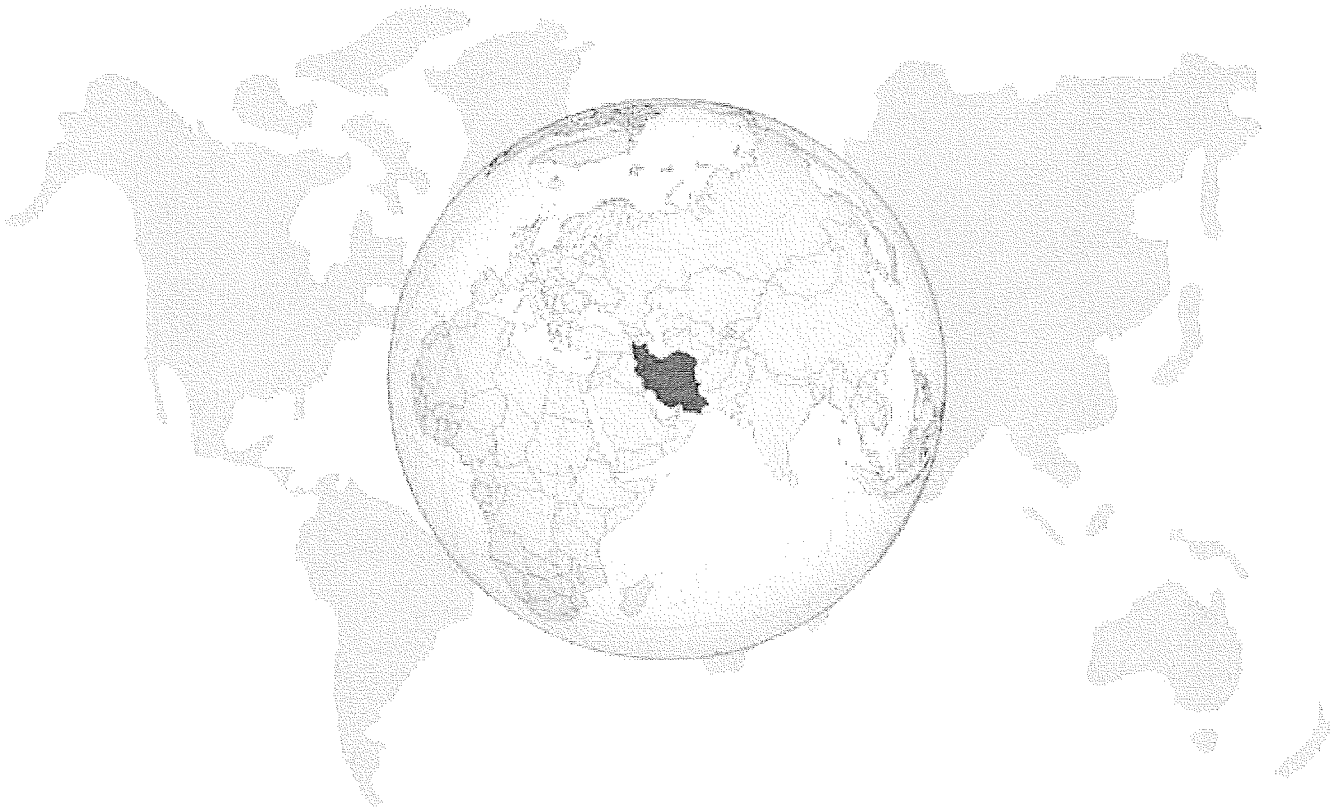
