

Seminar on Internal-External Quality Assurance (SieQA) 2024 will be held on 11 and 12 September 2024 at <u>Universiti Malaya</u>, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. SieQA 2024 is organised by <u>Quality Management and Enhancement Centre (QMEC)</u>, Universiti Malaya in collaboration with <u>Malaysian Higher Education Institutions Quality Assurance Network (MyQAN)</u> and <u>Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA)</u>.

With the theme of "Navigating the Future: Advancing Quality Assurance in an AI-Driven Educational Landscape," SieQA 2024 aims to provide a valuable insight on harnessing AI in the Quality Assurance landscape, particularly for personalised learning, preparing for the AI revolution and how AI can play a vital role in continuous improvement in higher education. 




Community Informed Policies and Gender Justice—an ASEAN Higher Education Story
