





Change the World Academy: Registration

To participate in the **Change the World Model UN Conference** it is necessary to send the application and face a selection interview with the staff

members of Change the World. Selected candidates are given the opportunity to enroll in Change the World Academy and attend the entire training course that ends with their participation in the CWMUN Conference. Access to CWMUN events is only granted to students who are regularly enrolled in the Change the World Academy and completed the preliminary course.

Entitled students are awarded with a merit-based grant worth €1,000 and can access to CWMUN Academy, which includes:

- Educational training course for the CWMUN NYC project and conference.
- · Access to the educational platform with exclusive content.
- · Live meetings on Zoom with Dedicated Tutors.
- · Participation in the CWMUN Mastery.
- Accommodation at the selected Hotel*.
- Participation in CWMUN New York Conference from 20th to 23rd March, 2025.

*The hosting hotel structure may vary based on availability and the number of participants. It is the responsibility and discretion of Diplomatici to organize students in one of the affiliated hotels.

Change the World Academy: Enrollment options

The pricing you see is only valid for students who have passed the selection interview and automatically benefit from the Associazione Diplomatici merit-based grant. Prices do not include airfare or visa expenses, which are the responsibility of participants. Associazione Diplomatici does not handle travel arrangements for students.



Citizens of VWP countries need to register with the US Department of Homeland Security three days before their visit. There is a \$14 fee for

registration application; when approved, the registration is valid for two years or until your passport expires, whichever comes first.

Visas

The US Visa Waiver Program (VWP) allows nationals of 38 countries to enter the US without a visa. The US VWP allows nationals from 38 countries to enter the US without a visa, provided they are carrying a machine-readable passport. For the up-to-date list of countries included in the program and current requirements, see the US Department of State website. If you are not part of these countries, please make sure to ask your American Embassy or Consulate for additional information about the documents you need to visit the U.S.

Letter of invitation

CWMUN is more than happy to assist you while getting a Visa offering help or writing your letter of invitation. However, writing a letter of invitation does not guarantee you are getting a Visa, CWMUN will not interfere with any Embassy or Consulate decisions or contact them on behalf on any person. Before planning your trip, please contact your local authorities for further information on how to get your Visa successfully.

If you need a letter, please email us and submit your passport information. A copy of your passport is mandatory to get your letter. A CWMUN Staff Member will get back to you with additional information in no time.

This information is only a guide. Some visa offices may ask for administrative fees. Make sure to have all info at your end before submitting your request.


NYC Safety Tips

To be safe in NYC is to use general common sense. However, with so many different neighborhoods and such dense population, there are some safety tips you should know when traveling in NYC. Keep Your Valuables Safe: The CWMUN host Hotel offers in-room safes that are laptop compatible. For peace of mind, we highly recommend storing your valuables in these free safes. Know Who is at Your Door: When you hear a knock on the door, make sure to check through the peep hole on the door before opening it. During the CWMUN week, CWMUN Security Staff Members will walk around floors at night to make sure everything is okay. They always wear an identification badge. Do not Travel in Unmarked NY Taxi Cabs: Commonly referred to as "Gypsy Cabs," these unmarked NYC taxicabs are usually non-metered, non-insured and non-licensed. Avoid a rip-off – or something worse – by denying a trip in these unmarked NY taxicabs.

Why Singapore?

Singapore is a popular international travel destination, contributing to the flowering of an important tourist industry. Singapore is a kind of microcosm of Asia, populated by Chinese, Malay, Indians and a large number of foreigners from all over the world. 

Train

Alight at Esplanade or Promenade[^] via the Circle Line, and City Hall* via the East West Line.

Follow these directions to get to Suntec Singapore:

- From CC3 Esplanade MRT Station (3 min): Take Exit A and follow the signage to our Centre
- From CC4 Promenade MRT Station (5 min):
 Take Exit C, walk through Suntec City Mall and follow the signage to our Centre
- From EW13 City Hall MRT Station (8 min):
 Walk through City Link Mall and then Esplanade Exchange to get here

Taxis are available for hire at the taxi stands in the Arrival areas of each Terminal. A ride to the city takes about 30 minutes and costs between S\$20 and S\$40. All fares are metered.

There is an additional Airport Surcharge for all trips originating from the Airport:

- Fri-Sun (5:00PM-12:00AM): S\$5 Airport Surcharge
- All other times: S\$3 Airport Surcharge
- Midnight surcharge (12:00 AM-6:00 AM): 50% of final metered fare
- Peak-hour surcharge (6:00 AM-9:30 AM, Mon-Fri and 6:00 PM-12:00 AM, Mon-Sun): 25% of final metered fare.

Visa Requirements

Visa Requirements

Foreign visitors must get their Permits or Entry Visas ready before proceeding to immigration clearance.

For more information on entry and visa requirements, please contact Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) via their 24-hour automated answering service at +65 6391 6100 or visit https://www.ica.gov.sg/. When

planning to visit Singapore please make sure to ask your Singapore Embassy in your country for additional information on how to get your permission. On a general note, your visa fees must be paid upon application and are non-refundable. Depending on the period, getting a Visa can take a while and you cannot make it to the Conference. Make sure to schedule your appointment at the Embassy in advance. If you plan it properly, your Visa processing time can take approximately three to twenty working days.






